As a business we purchase the native trees from a charitable trust Trees That Count <http://www.treesthatcount.co.nz> that have partnered with Tourism New Zealand to plant a forest for the future and making it easier for Tourism Companies and both domestic and international visitors alike to create canopies of carbon-sequestering trees for future generations to enjoy and to support efforts to address climate change.
